


Edit mode button at the top left of the screen 1. Click on the




2. Click the "Add content" button at the bottom of the instruction unit. And click on "Activity or resource".



3. Select the "Resources" tab in the window that opens. And select "URL".




4. Enter the following details:



- a. The name of the linked website by copying and pasting its URL.
- b. Add a description of the linked website

Note: You only need to "Choose a link" if you wish to search for a link to other websites. If you manually paste a website address from another site this step is not required.

5. The linked website can be opened by various methods under "Appearance":



- a) The "automatic" option displays it in the mode that best fits the user's personal computer settings.
- b) Embedding opens it on a page within the course website, the user not having to leave the system.
- c) Open (not recommended): Opens it *on top of* the course website page, clicking the link thus taking the user out of the system into the linked site.
- d) Pop-up (recommended) opens it in a new window.


Click the Save and return to course button at the bottom of the screen.




o2 | Embedding a YouTube Video

To embed a YouTube video, follow the previous steps up until choosing the internet address.

1. Under "External website address," click the "Choose a link" button to search for a website link




2. In the "File picker" window, type video the name or subject in the "Search videos" and click "Search"




3. Select the desired video






4. Click "Select this file" in the window that opens



5. Go to "Appearance" and select "Embed" under the "Display Mode" menu
